PROJECT: Coomeva Medical Centre – Anti-Graffiti Protection
LOCATION: Columbia

THE PROBLEM

The photograph shows the privately owned Coomeva Medical Centre in Bucaramanga, the external walls of which the owners wanted to protect against graffiti abuse without altering the appearance of the building.

The area to be coated totalled 100m².



THE SOLUTION



The walls were prepared in accordance with Thortex technical guidelines, ensuring the substrate was clean, dry and free from loose material. Two coats of Wall-Tech AG were then applied.

Wall-Tech AG is a two component, water-based, graffiti-resistant polyurethane coating which is micro-porous and therefore allows the masonry to breathe.

It is easy-to-use by brush or spray and with two coats offers effective protection to most masonry surfaces. As Wall-Tech AG is fast drying, the two coats can be applied on the same day.
